

Construction of 7 mini stadiums

Provision of a Youth Revolving Loan Fund to support youth programs across the country

144 Solar Piped Water Systems 80 fish ponds, in 15 sites

Construction and installation of 144 solar powered piped water systems for rural communities.

Construction of 80 fish ponds in 15 sites.

24 km Two Lane Dual Carriageway 50 km Urban Roads, within the GBA

Construction of a 24 km two-lane dual carriageway along the Bertil Harding Highway.

Construction of 50 km urban roads within the Greater Banjul Area in preparation for the OIC Summit.
