

# JANUARY-JUNE 2020 EXPENDITURE BRIEF

PREPARED BY THE DIRECTORATE OF BUDGET

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### INTRODUCTION

This brief presents an analysis of central government expenditure from January to end June 2020. It also aims to inform Senior Management about the composition of total expenditure by different classification, highlighting the absorption capacity of different budget entities (BEs), and give an indication of expenditure trends compared to the same period a year earlier. It should be noted that all expenditure referred to in this brief is solely Government Local Fund (GLF), and the report does not factor any donor funds (loans and grants), including projects across the country.

#### TOTAL GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE

Government's total expenditure as of end June 2020 amounted to **D7.8 billion**, which represents an increase of 11% compared to the same period last year, as indicated in Table 1.

Personnel Emolument (PE) and Other Recurrent (OC) collectively consumed 58 percent of total expenditure. PE has slightly increased from D1.994 billion in June 2019 to D1.996 billion in June 2020, representing a yearly growth of 0.1 percent.

In comparison to last year, Debt Service decreased by 52 percent from D1.8 billion to D906 million, whilst expenditure on Capital Development has increased by 167% relative to last year. Overall, Capital Development represents about 10 percent of the total GLF expenditure as of end June 2020.

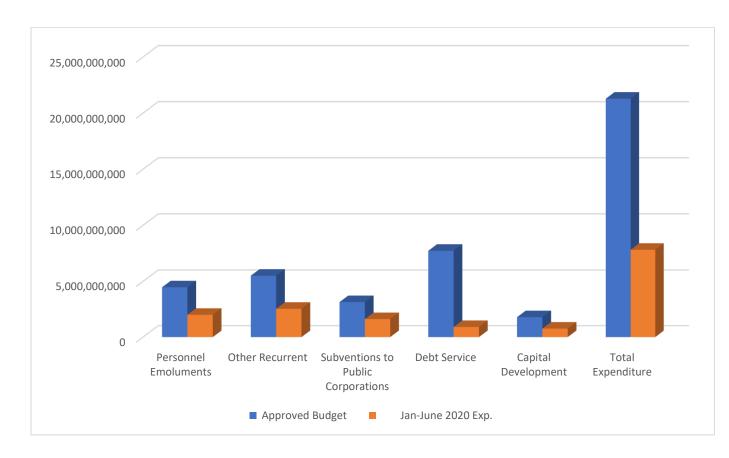

Table 2 above compares the different budget classes against the 2020 approved budget, highlighting the absorbtion capacity by budget class. Subventions to Public Corporations is the highest spending budget class with 51 percent of its budget consumed as at end June 2020. Debt Service remains the lowest absorbing budget class with 12% of its approved budget spent as at end June.

The different budget classes have collectively consumed 37% percent of the approved budget as at end June 2020.

Personnel Emolument has slightly increased from D1.994 billion to D1.996 billion. Basic Salary constitutes 49 percent of total PE, which registered a growth of 0.7 percent, slightly increasing from D969 million in 2019 to D975 million in 2020. Allowance has decreased by 3 percent as compared to the same period last year, from D886 million to D858 million.

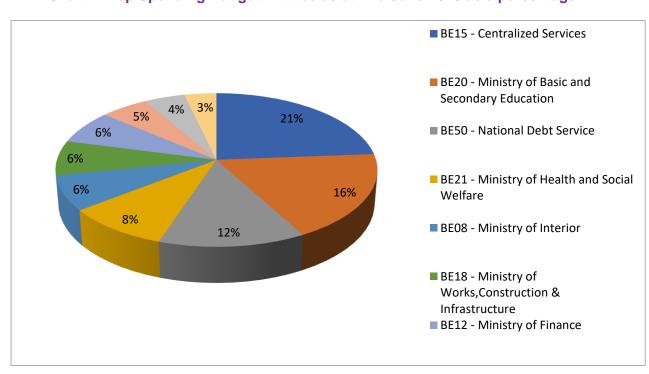
# I. TOP TEN SPENDING BUDGET ENTITIES (BEs)

The top ten highest spending Budget Entities collectively consumed 70 percent of total expenditure as of end June 2020. Centralized services and MOBSE topped the list, consuming 21 and 16 percent respectively.

## II. TOP TEN SPENDING BUDGET LINES

Roads and Bridges registered the highest absorbtion rate among the top spending line items, with 101 percent of its budget spent as of end June 2020. The COVID- 19 activities and Settlement of Confirmed debt both absorbed 76 percent of their budget for the year.
