

JANUARY-MAY 2020 EXPENDITURE BRIEF

PREPARED BY THE DIRECTORATE OF BUDGET

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INTRODUCTION

This brief presents an analysis of central government expenditure from January to end May 2020. It aims to inform Senior Management on the composition of total expenditure by different classification, highlight the absorption capacity of different budget entities (BEs), and give an indication of expenditure trends compared to the same period a year earlier. It should be noted that all expenditure referred to in this brief is solely Government Local Fund (GLF), and the report does not factor any donor funds (loans and grants), including those earmarked for development projects across the country.

TOTAL GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE

Government's total expenditure as of end May 2020 amounted to **D6.9 billion**, which represents an increase of 15 percent compared to the same period last year.

Personnel Emolument (PE) and Other Recurrent (OC) collectively consumed 56 percent of total expenditure. Meanwhile, PE has slightly decreased from D1.78 billion in May 2019 to D1.67 billion in May 2020, a decline of 6 percent.

In comparison to last year, Debt Service decreased by 47 percent from D1.6 billion to D898 million, which is partially as a result of the debt deferral from our creditors. Meanwhile, expenditure on Capital Development has increased by 183 percent relative to last year, mainly due to the first instalment paid towards the Banjul Rehabilitation Project. Overall, Capital Development consumed about 10 percent of the total GLF expenditure to date.

Table 2 above compares the different budget classes against the 2020 approved budget, highlighting their absorption capacities. Subvention to Public Corporations is the highest absorbing budget class with 46 percent of its budget consumed to date, whilst Debt Service remains the lowest with 12 percent of its' approved budget spent as of end May 2020.

The different budget classes have collectively consumed 33 percent of the approved budget.

Chart 1: Central Government Expenditure for End May 2020 compared to Approved budget, Source: IFMIS



Personnel Emolument decreased from D1.7 billion in May 2019 to D1.6 billion in May 2020, recording a year-to-year decline of 6 percent. Basic Salary constitutes 49 percent of total PE, which registered a growth of 2.4 percent, increasing from D796 million in 2019 to D815 million in 2020. Meanwhile, Allowances have decreased by 15.2 percent as compared to the same period last year, from D856.9 million to D727 million.

Table 3A above shows the approved budget for PE as compared to May 2020 expenditure. Basic Salary and Allowances consumed 37 and 38 percent of their approved budgets as of end May 2020. Meanwhile, expenditure on the ECA reached 46 percent of its annual budget.

I. TOP TEN SPENDING BUDGET ENTITIES (BEs)


The top ten highest spending Budget Entities collectively consumed 69 percent of total expenditure. Centralized Services and Debt Service topped the list, consuming 22 percent and 13 percent respectively.

II. TOP TEN SPENDING BUDGET LINES

Roads and Bridges registered the highest absorption rate among the top spending line items with 101 percent of its budget spent as at end May 2020. The COVID- 19 activities budget line has absorbed 69 percent of its budget for the year, whilst 73% of Settlement of Confirmed Debt budget line has been spent to date.
